I went to my old shop connected a diagnostic tool and interrogated all the modules. Am I missing something or is it just dead? I got a TCM and BCM lost communication. I don't have a BCM so that is expected. Now on to finding the TCM problem. Here is what I have tested. I have verified the red (pin 4 I Lost communication ECM/PCM/BCM and TCM. The loss of communication errors are not unusual when you have something plugged in to the OBD port.
