



Uzbekistan's backup power storage investment

TASHKENT, UZBEKISTAN (29 October) -- The Asian Development Bank (ADB), together with ACWA Power Company, Sumitomo Corporation, Chubu Electric Power Co. Inc., and Shikoku Electric Power Co. Inc., has signed a landmark financing package to build two utility-scale solar power plants. The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) is providing \$142 million in financing to two ACWA Power-led solar-plus-storage projects in central Uzbekistan. The EBRD has signed a financing package that will support the development of two large-scale solar-plus-storage projects in Uzbekistan. The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) is providing a comprehensive financing package of US\$ 142 million (EUR121 million) for two special-purpose vehicles (SPVs) that will develop Uzbekistan's and Central Asia's largest combined solar photovoltaic and battery energy storage project to date. The two SPVs--ACWA Power and Sumitomo Corporation, Shikoku Electric Power Company and Chubu Electric Power Company. The investment marks the first foray into large-scale battery energy storage in Uzbekistan. The project is forecast to produce approximately 2,300GWh of electricity annually once completed.
